

Dear Potential Community Partner,

We are so pleased to announce St. Mark's Episcopal Church request for funding applications for 2022 grants!

In 2021, St. Mark's Episcopal Church opened the St. Mark's Thrift Store to provide low cost goods to our surrounding community. The goal for this endeavor is to designate 50% of all yearly gross proceeds generated by sales to local mission and outreach through a grant program.

The purpose for the grant program is to expand the missional outreach of St. Mark's into our local community. Recognizing that good works are being done by other organizations, we desire to come alongside those missions through financial support.

In seeking complementary missional opportunities, we are especially interested in organizations whose core missions are in human trafficking, care for widows and orphans, and/or care for the Created Order.

Eligibility:

1. Must be a public charity and have tax exempt 501(c) 3 status. Organizations will be required to provide proof of this status.
2. Must be based in Florida and provide services within a 20-mile radius of our Cain Rd. campus.
3. If you are the supporting organization for another entity you must clearly specify whether you are requesting funding for your organization or for the organization you support.
4. Only one grant application per organization will be accepted.

Use of Grants:

Grants may not be used for the following purposes:

1. Benefit of specific individuals.
2. Endowment
3. Re-granting to other organizations or individuals

Grant Range:

Applicants are strongly encouraged only to request the specific amount needed to adequately fund their efforts.
